InfoTronics eliminates rounding errors. The corporate policy for rounding start and end times is automatically implemented and consistently applied throughout the 10 hotels.

Accurate Calculations

The company's unique pay rules are enforced fairly and impartially, and employees and management are confident that paychecks reflect actual work being done.

All told, InfoTronics cut the time it takes to prepare payroll data for nearly 400 employees to under four hours each pay period—instead of the previous 16 hours.
